The program Organized was an interactive session with Resource Person & Students. And this program was organized by Sri Sairam College of Engineering.

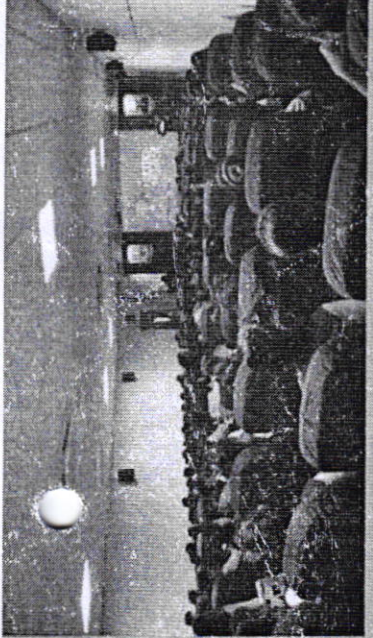
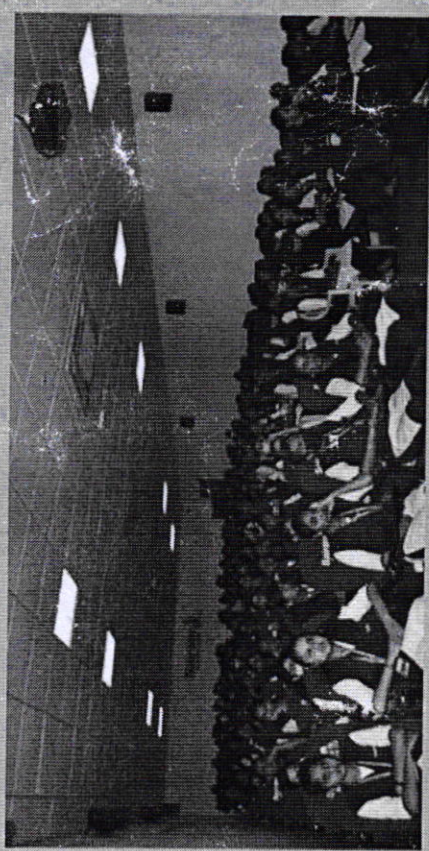
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This session highlighted the following principles.

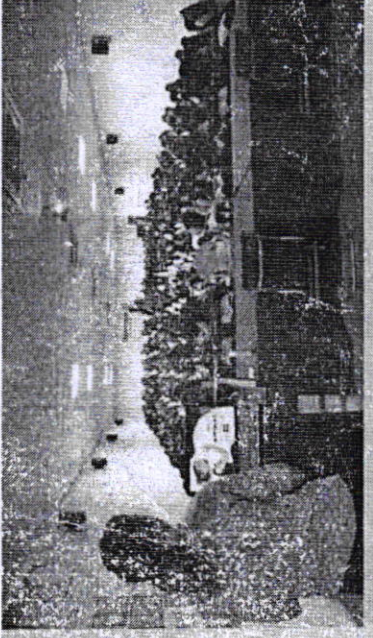
