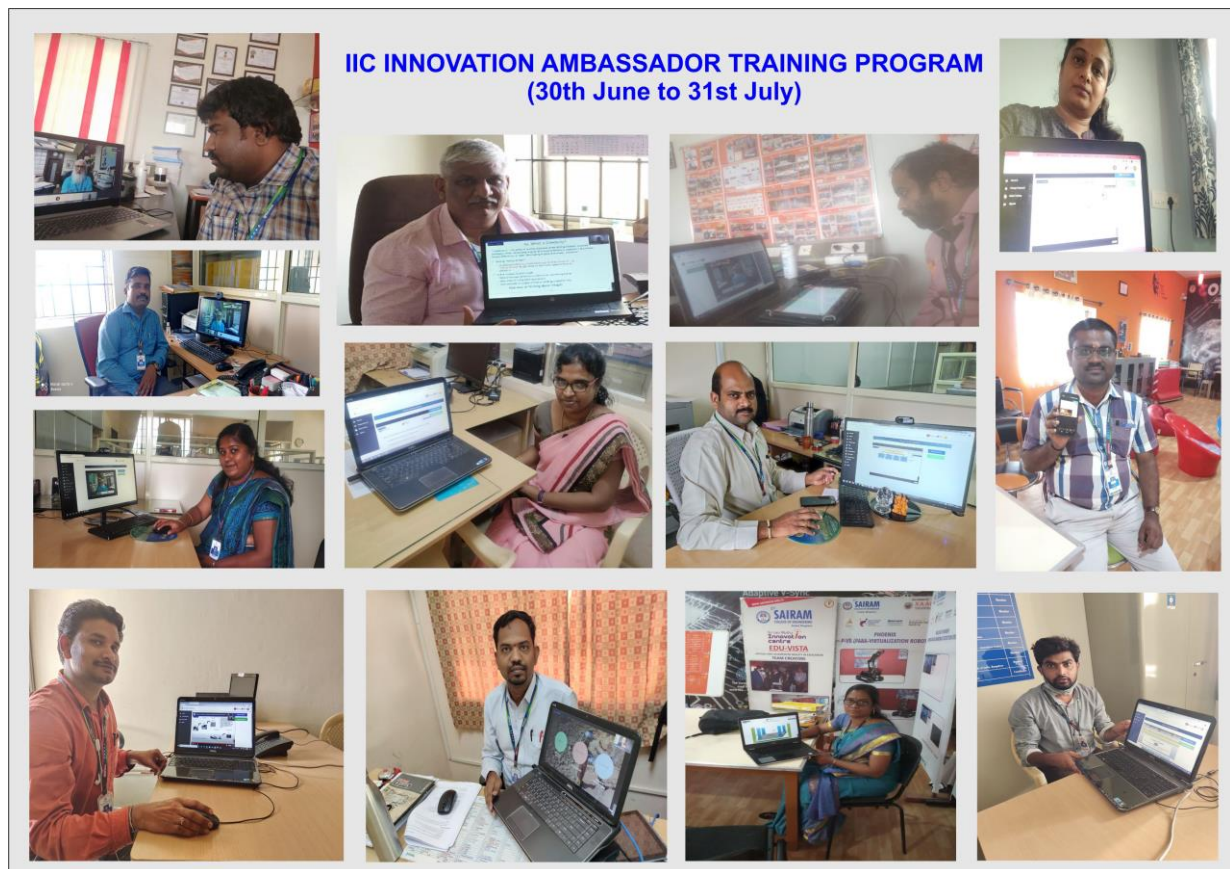


REPORT ON IIC-INNOVATION AMBASSADOR TRAINING PROGRAM

We glad to inform you that 13 faculties from our institution have undergone innovation Ambassador training organized by Institute Innovation Council from 30th June 2021 to 31st July 2021.

Objective of Training Program

Institution Innovation councils at institutes are envisioned an instrumental role to drive innovation and startup ecosystem at campus while connecting with ecosystem enablers at the regional and national levels. For this, the role of faculty being a member of IIC is very important. They play the role of a mentor or guide for young minds in their pursuit of innovation and entrepreneurship and it is equally crucial for mentors to have the adequate and right set of mentoring skills. Considering the fact that Indian HEIs are lacking in innovation and start-up mentor capacity to guide students on IPR, Innovation, and Entrepreneurship, Institutions Innovation council of MHRD's Innovation Cell aims to build mentorship capacity of IIC members through a series of training programs exclusively for faculty members and the trained IIC members are designated as "IIC - Innovation Ambassador". IIC-MHRD's Innovation Cell has taken a target to train more than 5000 faculties to develop mentoring skills on the above four themes by end of June 2020, end of IIC Calendar.

There were two level of training organized by IIC, Foundation Level for newly nominate faculties from the institution where we have nominated 10 faculties, Advance Level for present Innovation Ambassador where we have nominated 3 faculties.

Post-training these Innovation Ambassadors are felicitated with a token of recognition and responsibility which contains the badge of Innovation Ambassador along with AICTE and MIC logo. This token of recognition will reminisce Innovation Ambassadors about the responsibilities entrusted with them by MIC & AICTE.

After completion of training, these Innovation Ambassadors will have to complete various activities as prescribed and suggested by IIC, MIC. Innovation Ambassadors will be given activities at regular intervals to create awareness, inculcate entrepreneurial mindset, and bring cognizance about start-ups, IPR, and the importance of Innovation ecosystem enablers and facilitators among students and fellow faculty members. IIC Innovation Ambassadors will help MIC & AICTE to strengthen the grassroots innovation ecosystem in the country particularly in Higher Educational Institutions.

Role of IIC's Innovation Ambassador

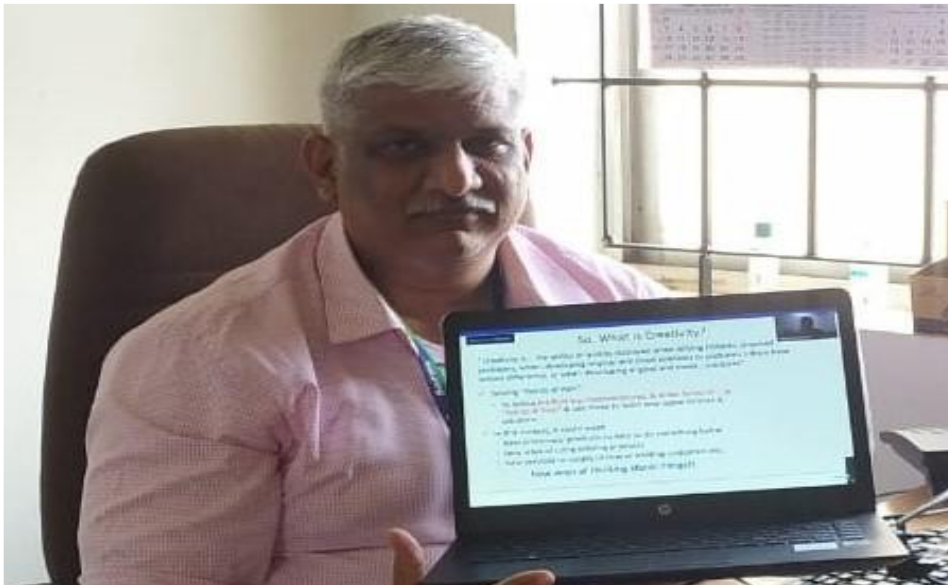
- Perform the role of mentor in their respective IICs

To retain the Innovation Ambassador tag, he/she will have to perform 4 activities voluntarily by IA

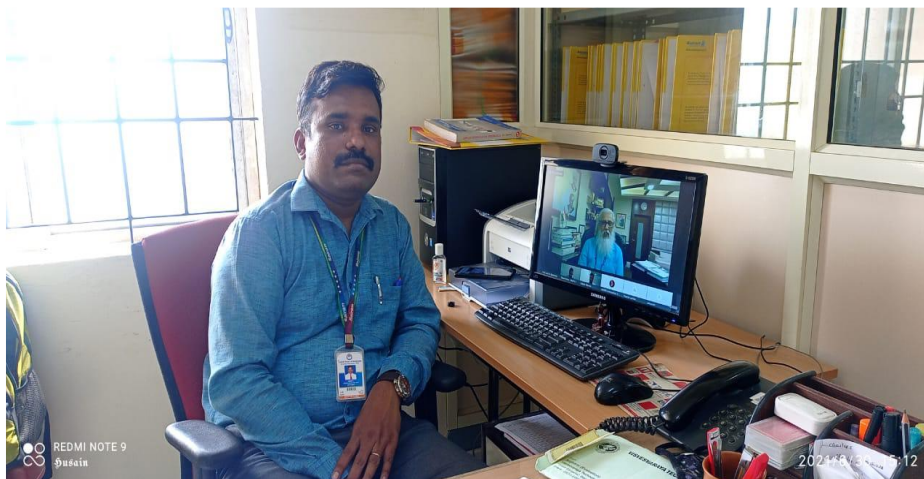
- Activities organized within the institute towards promoting & supporting. Innovation, IPR, and Start-up.

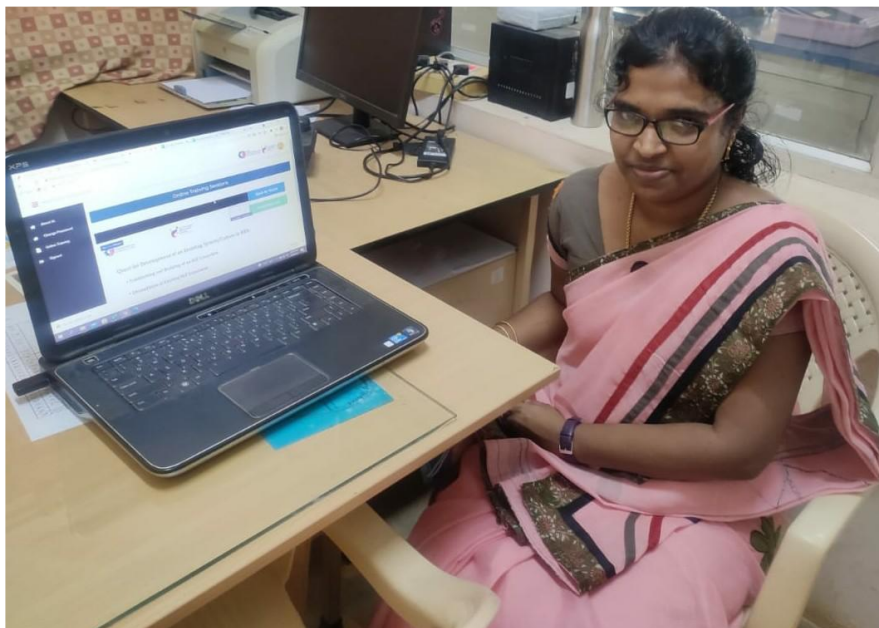

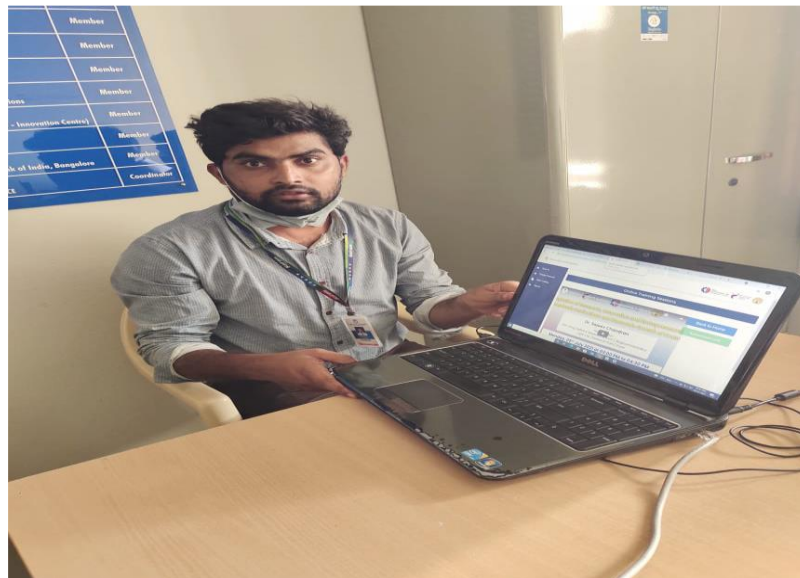

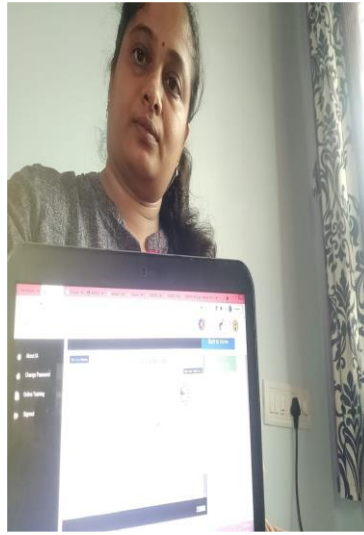
