Total 944 student participated and 42 faculty participants from 18 schools from in and around Hosur were attended this program also some of the parents were interacted with our faculty about the higher education.


Later the inauguration, Subject Expert session was started with 4 speakers in different subjects. The following experts from various Govt schools shared their views to the students for their examination preparation. The


