Report on "Global Education Opportunities and Pathways" – 22.11.2024

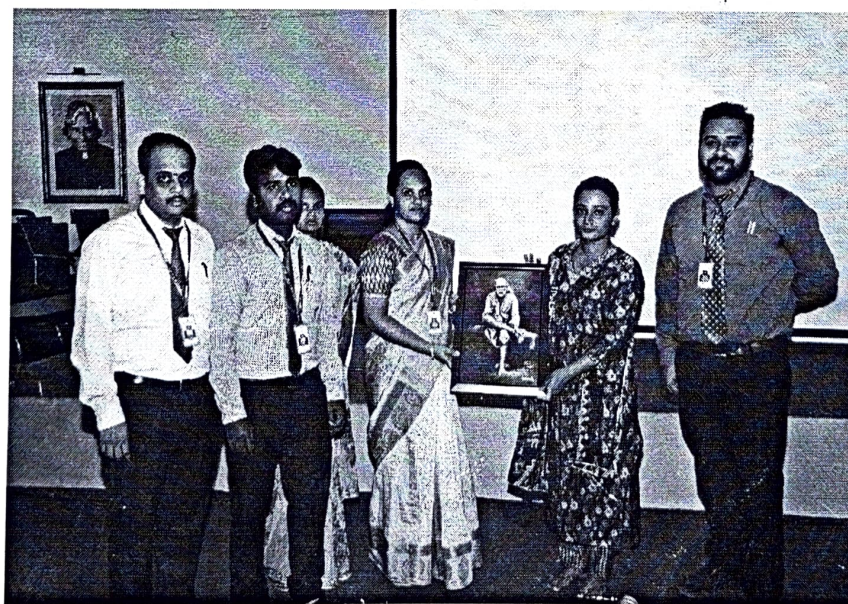


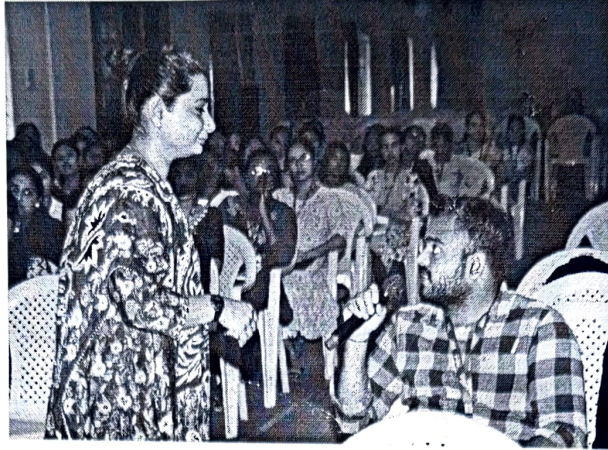
