### Report on Participation in AIORI-2 Train the Trainer Workshop

**Date of Workshop:** July 28, 2025

Jayakumar and Dr. Martin** of ECE department actively participated in the **AIORI-2 Train the Trainer Workshop Series**, a prestigious national-level initiative organized under the **Advanced Internet Operations Research in India (AIORI)** project, supported by **NIXI and MeitY, Government of India**.

The workshop was designed to build academic capacity in **Internet engineering, measurement, and protocol design**, with a strong focus on connecting the academic community with **Standards Development Organizations (SDOs)**.



## Key Highlights of the Workshop
