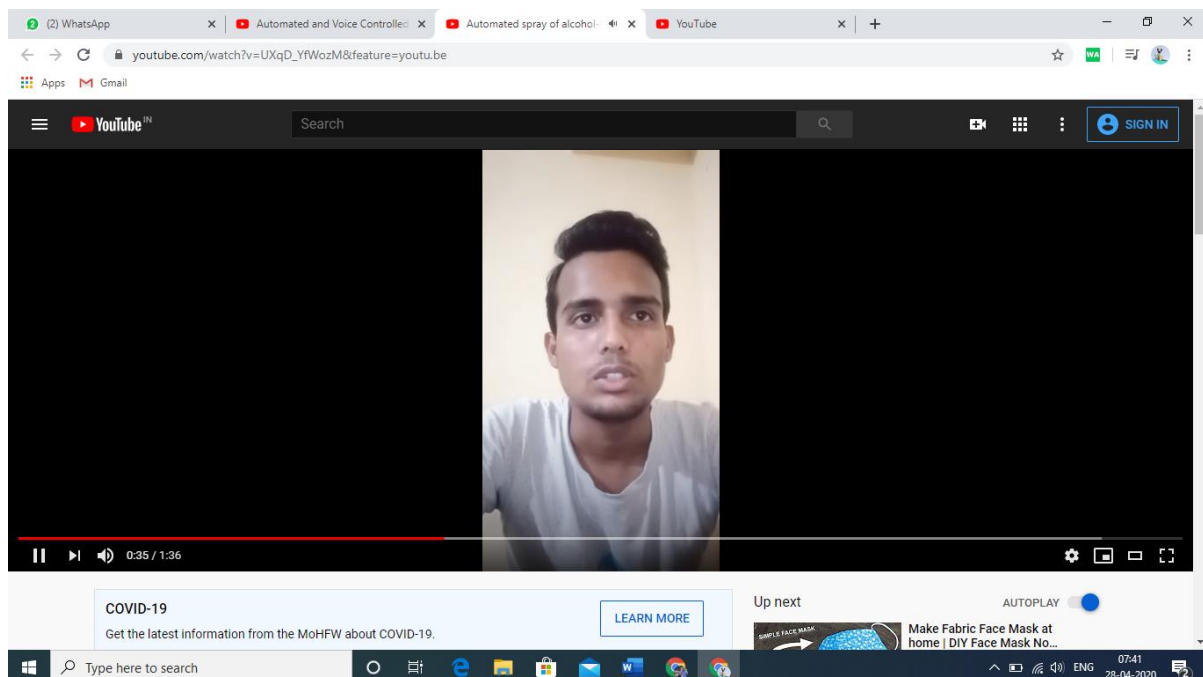


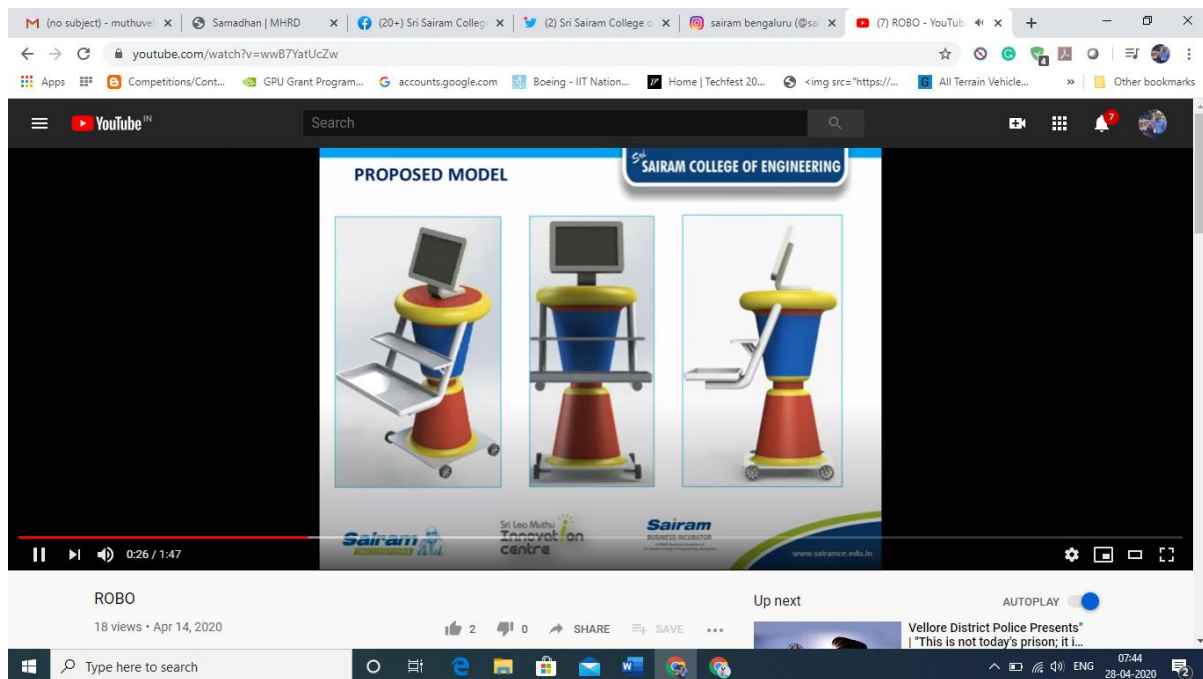
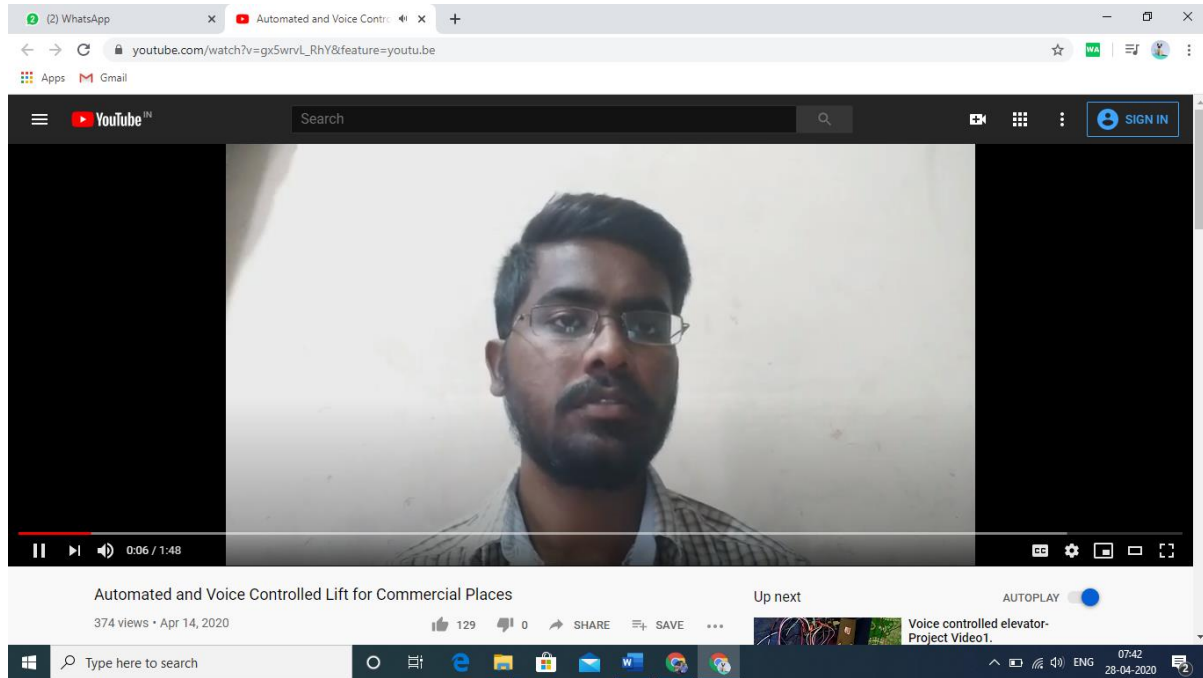
REPORT ON “SAMADHAN”
