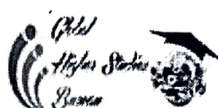

A Report on "GATE Awareness and Opportunities - Guiding students Towards Higher Education and Career Excellence"

The Higher education Cell of the institution in association with GATE-JAM office, IISC, Bengaluru organized an session for the III & IV year students titled "GATE Awareness and Opportunities - Guiding students Towards Higher Education and Career Excellence" on 12-08-2025 is to create awareness about GATE examination and preparations and various opportunities. Dr. Smitha J A, HOD, CSE welcomed Resource Persons and the students for this session and Dr. Harikrishna S, HOD, S&H presented mementos to the Resource Persons. Total three sessions were delivered by two distinguished speakers from the prestigious Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru – Mr. Chechani Pranjal Vishnukumar and Mrs. Paulomi Dam Kanunjna for around 500 students from III & IV year all branch students. Both resource persons, with their extensive experience in research and higher education, shared in-depth knowledge and practical guidance, making the session highly informative and inspiring for the attendees. They began by introducing the GATE examination, elaborating on its purpose, the wide range of disciplines covered, the examination structure, marking scheme, and the latest updates to the syllabus and exam format. Emphasis was placed on the significance of GATE not only as a qualifying exam for admission to postgraduate programs like M.Tech, M.E., and Ph.D. in IITs, NITs, IISc, and other reputed institutions but also as a gateway to lucrative career opportunities in Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and research organizations. The speakers highlighted that several international universities, particularly in Singapore and Germany, accept GATE scores for admission into postgraduate programs, thereby broadening the scope of opportunities for aspirants. The session provided detailed preparation strategies, stressing the importance of a well-planned timetable, consistent practice, mock tests, and effective revision techniques. Students were advised to focus on conceptual clarity, solve previous years question papers, and use standard reference books to strengthen their preparation. The speakers also discussed the balance between semester studies and GATE preparation, encouraging

students to start early and progress steadily. A significant portion of the talk was devoted to exploring the career avenues available after GATE qualification, including research fellowships, government-funded projects, and positions in national laboratories, as well as the enhanced employability in both academia and industry. The motivational aspect of the session was particularly impactful, as the speakers shared personal experiences, success stories, and tips on building resilience, managing stress, and maintaining focus during preparation. Students were encouraged to cultivate a growth mindset, self-discipline, and perseverance, as these qualities are crucial not only for cracking competitive exams but also for long-term career excellence.

The interactive Q&A session that followed saw enthusiastic participation, with students seeking advice on effective study schedules, selecting the right preparation resources, and understanding the nuances of GATE's application in various career paths. The clear and thoughtful responses provided by the speakers further reinforced the relevance and applicability of the guidance shared.

In conclusion, the event proved to be a highly enriching experience that not only deepened the students' understanding of GATE but also broadened their perspective on higher education and career possibilities. 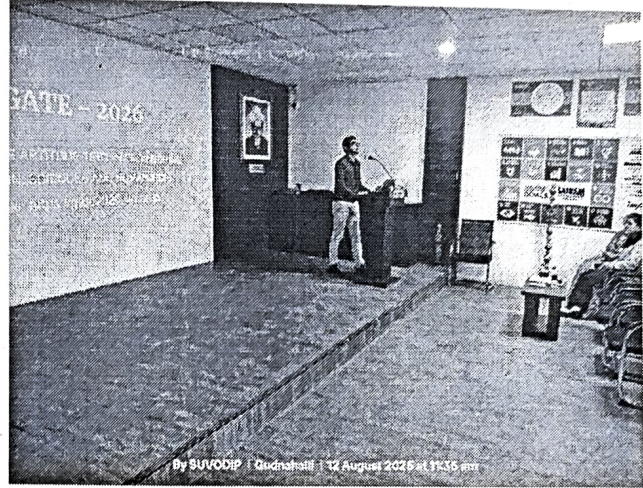

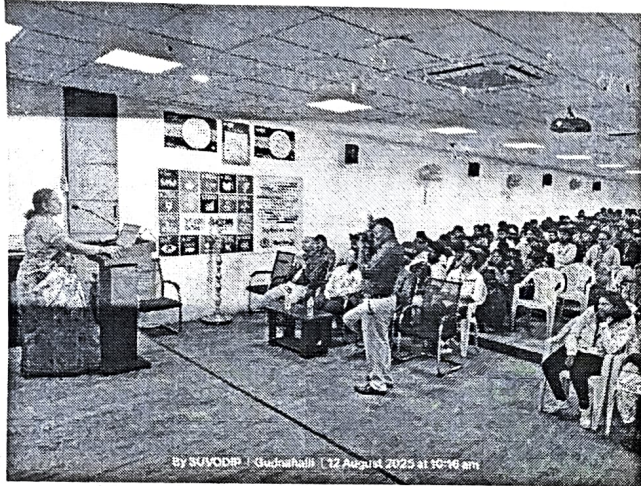
